Divine Mercy

Pray the Divine Mercy Novena of Chaplets. A novena is typically nine days of prayer in preparation of a celebration of a feast day. For the Divine Mercy Novena the Chaplet is

recited perpetually at the Hour of Great mercythree o'clock pm. (If possible) Jesus specifically asked that the chaplet be recited as a novena. He promised, "By this Novena (of Chaplets), I will grant every possible grace to souls."
