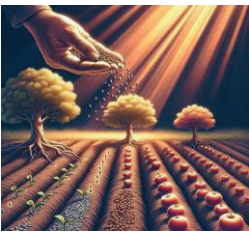

Humanitarian Relief – Venezuela Earthquake

A devastating series of earthquakes struck north-central Venezuela on June 24, 2026, making it the country's largest seismic disaster in more than a century. Two powerful earthquakes-a magnitude of 7.2 followed just 39 seconds later with a magnitude of 7.5 near Yumare/San Felipe in Yaracuy State, causing catastrophic damage across much of the country where buildings collapsed, roads and bridge were damaged, and power and communications have been disrupted.
